

English

We will be reading The Three Little Pigs. In writing we will be focusing on writing full sentences and using full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We will be retelling a traditional tale as well as writing our part of our own based on the text. We will also be writing a recount about a local visit.

Science

We will be learning to name materials and describe their properties. We will also be learning why different materials have different uses.

Geography

We will be learning to describe our local area. We will be using and drawing maps and finding out the history of our local area. We will also choose ways to improve our local area.

Additional Experiences

We will explore our local area.

French

In the first part of the term, we will be focusing on French greetings. Children will learn how to greet and introduce themselves to one another in French. Following on from this, children will learn some well-known French songs and stories.

This half term our driving question is:
What is it like to live in our local area?



Computing

We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe online. We will be creating films to show the steps of a recipe.

Religious Education

We will be learning about the celebration of harvest.

PSHE

We will be learning ways to keep ourselves safe and how to cope with our worries.

Art and Design Technology

We will be creating a self-portrait using marks, lines and curves and understand proportion.

Mathematics Mastery

We will be counting using a ten frame and bead strings and develop our addition and subtraction strategies. Through investigation we will explore number bonds that have the same answer e.g. $3+3=6$, $4+2=6$. We will be working with numbers within 10.

Physical Education

The first term will see the children build confidence in their agility, balance and coordination. They will learn how to maintain control over the movements during different exercises and routines.

Music

In the first term, we will concentrate on learning a song off by heart and singing in unison with one another at the correct pitch.
