

English

We will be reading George's Marvellous Medicine By Roald Dahl. In our writing sessions, we will be looking at character descriptions and writing instructions. We will be focussing on writing clear sentences, adjectives and using different types of conjunctions within our writing.

Science

In science, we will be looking at everyday materials and their uses. We will be identifying, classifying and experimenting with different materials we are familiar with. Also, we will look at our role in plastic pollution and what we can do to help.

History

We will be studying about the Great Fire of London and thinking about how this could have been prevented. We will look at key events that took place and how this changed London for the future. As well as this, we will be learning about important people involved in this event.

French

We will be learning important and well known French stories and also learning more about the French culture.

This half term our driving question is:
How could the Great Fire of London have been prevented?



Computing

We will become photographers during this unit. We will look at how to take pictures and what technology we can use to take pictures. We will be creating a scrapbook of photographs that we take over the term.

Religious Education

We will be looking at the story of Passover and learning about how it is remembered and celebrated.

Art and Design technology

We will be looking at the collages related to the Great Fire of London. By the end of this unit, we will have created our own pictures of the Great Fire using a range of materials such as paint, card, tissue paper and felt.

Mathematics Mastery

We will be looking at multiplication and division, measuring length, and interpreting data through graphs. In this unit we will be continuing to build on our times table skills by counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s forwards and backwards.

Physical Education

We will be focussing on building stamina through completing the daily mile which will build resilience and grit. Year 2 will also be looking at different ways they can throw, catch and travel with the ball in different scenarios to give them the skills to progress in a variety of sports.

Music

In this unit, we will be looking at expressing ourselves through rhythm. We will be exploring how our body parts and instruments can help us create different rhythms.
