

English

We will be reading the tales of King Arthur. In writing we will be focusing on our own version of the stories we have read. Children will create fact files about Kings and Queens. In grammar we will focus on sentence structure, nouns and adjectives.

Science

In science, we will be looking at animals and their needs for survival. We will look at how animals change throughout their lives, including how we have changed since we were babies.

History

We will be studying about monarchs and focusing on some important kings and queens. We will also be looking at what these kings and queens did and who we think was the most powerful.

Additional Experiences

A day of dressing up as a king or queen.

French

We will be learning French greetings: what is your name and where do you live?

This half term our driving question is:

Computing

We will be using search engines to research information. We will be creating mind maps and presentations. We will be learning about internet safety.

Religious Education

We will explore bread as a symbol at the Harvest festival.

Art and Design technology

We will be looking at the artist Holbein and learning how to draw self-portraits. We will be working on improving our sketching and shading skills.

Mathematics Mastery

We will begin to add and subtract multiples of ten to any number within 100. We will use number bonds to add and subtract two digit numbers. We will also be looking at developing our speed of mental arithmetic.

Physical Education

To focus on building stamina by taking part in various boxercise routines. Children to practice their throwing and catching skills working on their hand-eye coordination through a variety of games, such as benchball and catching in groups.

Music

We will develop increased levels of pitch and performance with a sense of beat. Children will make whole class music.
